Our hearts are uplifted with gratitude and love from this gesture and hope and renewed faith that all will be well with our child. While organizing her play space was not top of our mind for us as we are consumed with so many other complexities related to kiddos care, it was weighing heavily on my mind once we started thinking of what we need to get organized to come back home in the summer. She is not the same toddler that left home last year to go to what we thought would be routine blood work. She has experienced so much and grown/changed so much and developed new interests in the past 10 months away from her sanctuary and bringing her back home to the same space as her younger self was simply not going to work. How serendipitous and miraculous that Alina reached out to me Within 24 hours of us starting to wonder how and when we were ever going to find the time to get things done so as to welcome our child back home. God and the universe work in mysterious ways indeed!

The same can be said for her outdoor play structure. Our care team brought up the need for her to play and how that will be an integral part of her recovery. Two weeks later you called me up regarding the play structure! We will discuss with her team this week and are hoping they will be ok with us taking her to play outdoor for 30-60 mins over the weekends. I will keep you posted. This will be such a blessing and aid in the strengthening / PT recovery process. She often looks at the play structure in the park and we keep deferring saying we will go when safer. This will be such a joy and delight for her.

Thank you also for the tremendous organization you have built. Every little thing done by the countless volunteers, partners and the board reflects your personal energy, Commitment to the mission and in Service of helping children who should never have to go through such battles and the empathy you have for families. We are humbled, grateful and in awe of the movement you/ Stan and the team have built with Rooms of Hope and hope to be part of the giving back effort in future years

Please let all the volunteers know that gift of time is perhaps the greatest gift we can give anyone as there is no price to it. Our family is full of gratitude for everything they have done for our child and that it will be an integral part of her healing and recovery. They are now a part of our child's journey and fight that we fervently pray and determined for her to win, God willing.


